Details: Contest participation is open to all children residing in affordable housing assisted directly or supported under community development and affordable housing programs administered by a Utah NAHRO member agency (i.e.; Public or Section 8 assisted housing, CDBG, HOME, LIHTC).

Entries will be judged by conference participants at the Utah NAHRO Spring Conference April 18-20 in St. George, Utah. One winning entry from each category will be forwarded to compete against the other regional entries at the Colorado and Mountain Plains NAHRO joint conference May 14-16 in Vail, Colorado. Conference participants will judge between the regional state winners and send one winner from each age category to NAHRO in August for the National competition. Regional state winners will also receive a \$100.00 Visa gift card.

Utah NAHRO Member Housing Authorities and Community Development Organizations may submit up to three posters and narrative from each age category.

Age categories of competition: Elementary - K to 5th grade; Middle - 6th to 8th grade; and High - 9th to 12th.

Poster Specifications:

- Theme - "What Home Means to Me"
- Size - All posters must be 22"x28" for judging
- Short Narrative (100 words or less) explaining theme

Prizes: **State Prizes: Utah NAHRO will provide \$100 Visa Gift Cards for first place winners in the three age categories.**

National Prizes: 12 national honorees will receive \$100 Visa Gift Card and 1 grand prize honoree will receive an iPad as well as transportation & lodging for honoree and family to be recognized at NAHRO's March 2019 Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C.
